BOOK SIGNING FOR RANDOLPH PHOTOGRAPHY BOOK

Everyone is invited to a book signing at the John L. Street Library on Saturday morning, October 22nd from 5:00 till 7:00 PM for the authors of the book *Mrs. Randolph, a small town portrait*. Kim Fortner and Paul Fourshee will be in the board room of the library for those interested in purchasing a book or having their book signed. They will also be at the Janice Mason Art Museum on Saturday October 27th from Noon till 4:00 PM.

This fascinating coffee table book is a retrospective presentation of the portrait photography of Mamie Crute Randolph. The research is by Fortner and Fourshee with over 500 photographs submitted by residents of Cadiz, Kentucky and Sheridan, Indiana.

Mamie Randolph was a photographer in Cadiz from 1893 to 1914 when she moved to Sheridan, IN, and continued the business until she died in 1946. Mr. Fourshee says, "There is hardly a family in Cadiz or Sheridan who doesn't have a picture with Mrs. Randolph's name stamped on it." This book, a photo album actually, offers a look at a community at its finest, when having one's picture made was an event. Ms. Fortner said, "In this book we see our ancestors presented in their Sunday go-to-meeting best."
